Position Responsibilities:

- Maintain watch over property and grounds against trespassing, vandalism and fire hazards.
- o Maintain a safe and orderly work site.
- Maintain safe and organized storage areas.
- Work with maintenance supervisor assigned to make repairs.
- o Make minor repairs to facilities and equipment.
- o Remove snow as assigned.
- o Maintain grounds in clean, sanitary and orderly condition.
- Operate heating, lighting, ventilation and electrical controls as specified or required.
- o Perform routine lubrication services and minor preventative maintenance services.
- Inspect building and report deficiencies.
- Keep track of supplies and make necessary orders for supplies.
- Maintain records as required by the County.
