

Summers County Schools

School Closings and Delay Information for Parents

When school is cancelled or delayed due to inclement weather, Summers County will use the following options. Announcements for all school closings or delays will be given in detail through the countywide calling system and online at: scswv.us or <https://wvde.state.wv.us/closings/>.

Option #1: Snow Day

Your child will have no instruction. This option will be used when there is extreme weather and travel is dangerous.

Option #2: Non-Traditional Instructional Day

Your child will receive instruction through Google Classroom or packets. This work must be turned in and will be graded. This option will be used when conditions are safer, and staff can report.

Delays

2-hour delay- students and staff will report two hours later.

3-hour delay- students will report three hours later. Staff will report on a two hour delay.

Consult your child's teacher or principal for the school's specific delay schedule.

COVID-19 Related Remote Learning

This will only be used in the event of a closure due to a school outbreak or staffing issues related to COVID-19. Expectations will be similar as a Non-Traditional Instructional day.
